Camp Registration

You can register your child on June 9, 2019 at the Chesapeake Boathouse between 2-5 P.M. This is where your child will receive their camp T-shirt and you will also fill out a BSA Health and Medical Form. All Scouts, siblings (participating and non-participating), will need to complete and submit a BSA Health & Safety Form (Parts A&B). Forms will be returned at the end of the day camp (June 14). Forms not picked up will be destroyed. You will also receive additional information about the camp, and we will address any concerns that you may have.

DAY CAMP SESSION

Day Camp sessions begin with check-in outside The Devon Boathouse at 7:30 A.M.-8:00 each morning. Day Camp ends each afternoon with check-out at 2:45-3:15 P.M.

WHAT TO BRING

Please read carefully and make sure your child has all the following items daily. We appreciate your attention to this list.

- Day Camp T-shirt
- ID Lanyard
- Small day/backpack- (in which all the following items fit into)
- Water bottle
- Closed toed shoes to be worn- (No Sandals)
- Sunscreen (please arrive to camp with sunscreen on)

The Camp Staff of the 2019 Adventure on the River Summer Day Camp is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

Do not send electronics with your child!

LUNCH AND SNACKS

Your child will be provided lunch daily, if you wish to pack a healthy snack please store that in your child's backpack. Please let us know on the BSA Health and Safety Form if your child has any food allergies.

WEATHER

Weather is expected to be hot. Water jugs will be posted at, or very near each location a Scout activity is occurring. In the event of rain or other severe weather, Devon Boathouse staff will advise the camp to seek shelter.

EMERGENCIES

Any non-life threatening Criminal Activity, Medical or Fire Emergencies will first be handled by allowing a Staff Member to contact the appropriate authorities. We prefer the Camp Director contact the appropriate authorities, however, for any Life or Death or time critical matter, immediately contact 911, then call the Camp Director, Jamaal Brooks at 405-669-6427.

CONTACT INFORMATION

Parents/Guardians should always call **Tina Clark (Camp Administrator) at 405-206-6227** if their child will not be attending camp that day. Unless it is an emergency please try not to contact Directors' during camp hours.

CAMP BEHAVIOR POLICY

As camp staff, we want the week of camp to have a positive impact on all Scouts. Therefore, we would like to outline our discipline policy for you to review with your child. Should an infraction occur, we will use the following policy:

1. The first time a camper breaks a rule, your child's Camp Walking Leader will explain the broken rule and why it is important for that rule to be followed. The incident will be documented and submitted to the Camp Administration Staff daily.
2. After the second incident the Camp Director(s) and the child will discuss the rule and infraction. The incident will be documented and submitted to the Camp Administration Staff daily.
3. Should inappropriate behavior continue; the third incident will result the Camp Staff Advisors (Jonathan Still and Wilda Ortiz) contacting the child's parent/guardian. This contact will result in a complete dismissal from the 2019 Adventure on the River Summer Day Camp. **No refunds will be given for dismissal from the camp for discipline issues!**
