



Join us on Saturday, March 28, 2020 to commemorate the 25th anniversary of the Oklahoma City Bombing.

The OKC National Memorial and Museum, along with Ma-Nu Lodge, will be hosting a Scouting day, offering museum tours, advancement opportunities, and service projects. Lunch is included.

Registration is limited to the first 1200 people. Cost is \$20 and includes a commemorative patch.

Scouts and scouters of all ages, units, and councils are invited to participate in this event. Families are welcomed and encouraged to attend as well. The Order of the Arrow will conduct a memorial service at the end of the day to honor those affected by the tragedy. We are asking for 168 volunteers (youth will be given priority) dressed in full field uniform to participate.
